

Master of Education

(Leadership)

The Master of Education (Leadership) program engages students in critically examining, refining, and transforming educational discourse and practice through a biblical lens. This course equips students to reimagine, develop, and lead flourishing, hope-filled learning communities, contributing to the task of transformative education.

Designed primarily for school leaders and classroom practitioners seeking to develop their leadership skills, this program fosters reflective practice, critical thinking, and effective communication within Christian education. Participants will refine their leadership craft by deeply engaging with contemporary educational challenges from a faith-based perspective. The course includes research options.

The course is primarily accessed through our Learning Management System (LMS), Moodle, with live class gatherings online offered, providing study flexibility. Assessments are varied and allow students to apply their learning within their local educational context.

As the postgraduate provider within Christian Education National (CEN), the National Institute for Christian Education fosters a supportive scholarly learning community. Even in a distance-learning environment, students benefit from regular interaction, collaboration, and mentorship alongside like-minded peers. They will also have access to highly qualified senior lecturers and experienced Christian educators, ensuring both academic and practical support throughout their journey.

Entry Requirements

Eligible Master of Education (Leadership) applicants will have an undergraduate qualification in education or a postgraduate degree in education or teaching.

Applicants whose first language is not English must demonstrate proficiency in spoken and written English adequate to undertake the course. This would normally be equivalent to a minimum IELTS score of 7.

Recommended Study Pathway

Graduate Certificate of Education (Leadership)

This Certificate consists of the four core subjects and is a separate degree option or an early exit point from the Master of Education (Leadership) course. It can be completed full-time in one semester or part-time over a maximum of four years.

Master of Education (Leadership)

This degree consists of eight subjects and can be completed full-time in two semesters (one year) or part-time over a maximum of seven years.

Course Structure

The National Institute offers three study periods per year, each based on 13 weeks of content.

Sem 1: March to June

Sem 2: July to November

Summer Intake: November to February

Single subjects are worth 10 credit points (cp) with 1 credit point representative of 10 hours of work per week equivalent.

Graduate Certificate of Education (Leadership)

This Certificate requires an aggregate of 40 credit points from the following: three core subjects (EDU400/a, EDU501/a, EDU505) plus one elective subject (from EDU561, EDU565, or EDU506).

Master of Education (Leadership)

This degree comprises 80 total credit points, or 8 subjects, for completion. This consists of:

- Four core subjects (40 cp)
- Two or three elective subjects (20/30 cp), and
- One capstone subject (10 or 20 cp) according to the subject list attached.

Students interested in a research option with the possibility of moving into Higher Degree Research in the future may choose to complete two electives and undertake a 20-credit point Education Research Project (EDU598), upon academic approval.




